

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING - 2 DECEMBER 2020

PROPOSED 2021 MEMBERSHIP FEES

Due to the disruption to club activities from the liquidation of a subsidiary company and the ongoing COVID-19 restrictions, the committee has decided not to propose an increase current membership fees in 2021 but members should anticipate increases in 2022. The committee propose that membership fees for 2021 be set as follows:

Full membership:	£135.00 (no change but see notes on name)
Full membership (joint):	£195.00 (no change but see notes on name)
Retired membership:	£65.00 (no change)
Retired membership (joint):	£97.00 (no change)
Overseas membership:	£63.00 (no change)
Overseas membership (joint):	£95.00 (no change)
Young persons membership (full time students under 21)	£25 (NEW – see notes)
Flying membership:	£200 (NEW – see notes)
Flying membership (joint)	£300 (NEW – see notes)
Flying membership (day)	£20 (NEW – see notes)

Additional propositions from the committee to address the fact that 25% of the members pay 75% of the fees:

- 50% discount for new members joining in the second half of the membership year (not applicable for late payment renewals)
- No new retired members existing retired members may continue with their current membership or have the option to transferring to make a full contribution
- No new life members existing life members may continue with the current membership as they have all helped the club in the past by taking up life membership, but will also have the option of transferring to a make a full contribution
- Life members will need to confirm annually that they wish to continue with their life membership. This will be done at annual renewal time to ensure we are able to keep records up to date for communication purposes

Notes (subject to new constitution and rules being in place prior to implementation)

- New "Young persons" membership to encourage youth. This will include Flying privileges
- New "Flying" memberships are subject to the finalisation of flight training agreement
- "Flying" memberships are memberships include all club privileges and additionally provide membership to the flight training organisation required for flight training and aircraft rental
- To avoid confusion between "Full" and "Flying" membership, it is proposed to rename "Full" to "Ordinary"
- For the avoidance of doubt, members who fly their own aircraft do not need to be "Flying" members and can remain in current membership categories.
- Members who need airside access can get this enabled on their membership card
 - No cost for Full (Ordinary) members or Flying members
 - $\circ\quad$ £30 one-off fee for retired and life member
 - Replacement card (for any membership category) £30 one-off fee
