



Renewing your membership using the new MemberMojo system

Dear member,

We have migrated our membership data from the old legacy system to a new dedicated membership software system to manage and administer all membership related processes.

All members will have the ability to manage their personal data themselves by editing their profile as required, and it will be the responsibility of the member to keep their information up to date.

This provides an ideal opportunity during the 2021 renewal process for members to review the existing old data that we hold and ensure it is correct and up to date.

You can renew and manage your own data just using your email address – you do not need a password. If you select to log in by email the system will send you a link to allow you to log in. However, you do have the option to set a password should you want.

Please note that at the 2020 AGM it was agreed to rename “Full Membership” to “Ordinary Member ship” to remove confusion with the new “Flying Membership” that will be coming in next year to provide all the benefits of the Ordinary (previously Full) membership with the additional benefits provided by the new Flight Training organisation including aircraft rental.

2021 Renewal Process

The membership year runs up to 31 January each year with renewals being able to be made online up to 2 months in advance.

Direct Debits – *please note that the club are no longer able to offer a direct debit facility but are looking with our bank how we might be able to do this in future. Unfortunately, that means that for the 2021 renewals members will need to either pay by credit card or bank transfer.*

The new membership system will send the following reminder emails:

- Renewal Notice (28 days before expiry)
- Expiry Warnings (9 days and 2 days before expiry)
- Membership Expired (1 day after expiry)
- Recently Expired (28 days after expiry)

Click on the blue “Confirm your details and renew your membership” link to start the renewal process

Once you click on the link you are taken into the membermojo system to start your renewal.



Within the membermojo system you can setup a password so that you do not need to use the email sign-in and verification process each time, however you will still be able to use the sign-in method at any time.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Some members have reported that they seem to get into a loop where they keep entering their email address at the login page to send an email that then sends them back to the login page.

It appears that they had actually logged in and did not realise it.

Note the differences show below:



If you see you are logged in (your name in the top right instead of “Log In” then just click on “Your Membership” in the heading line.

Checking your details and confirming your renewal

The system then shows you your current details as held on the system. Note that for the 2021 renewals these will be old details migrated from the previous system which may well be out of date.

Please check and update all your emails and update a photo (this can be used in future for membership cards) then agree to the terms and conditions
