Following the decision at the AGM on 30th April, to reinforce the Club's status as a Members Only Club, we will be introducing a new tier of membership – Social Membership. This will be at a reduced subscription of £100 for Single Membership or £150 for Joint. The Social membership will carry no voting rights and the proposed bar discount will not apply. Social members will be permitted one guest as opposed to three for Ordinary Members. The Social membership will be available when joining or renewing for 2025.

All existing members may stay with the tier that they are already on, or switch to the new tier if they think it is more beneficial to them.

Members who have Airside Access, must be either Ordinary, Retired, Young Persons or Flying Members.

A Visitors Book will be placed in the entrance to the clubroom for guests to be signed in. It is important that all guests are signed in and that guests are reminded that they are not permitted to be admitted to the Club on more than twelve occasions in any year (regardless of the Member making the introduction).

Members will still be able to use the clubroom in the evenings for Parties provided that member is always present.

Several groups will be given Corporate Memberships so that they can continue to use the Café/Bar.

A list of Corporate Member groups will be displayed behind the bar.
