We're delighted to invite you to a captivating presentation by Andrew Sayers, whose extraordinary career spans military service, aviation training, and record-breaking achievements.

A Fellow of the Royal Institute of Navigation and Member of the Royal Aeronautical Society, Andrew jointly holds the Guinness World Record for the longest flight simulator session — alongside none other than Buzz Aldrin.

Before entering aviation, Andrew served in the British Army with the Royal Military Police, Intelligence Corps, and the Black Watch, rising from Private to Major. He later trained pilots for British Airways, BMI, Aer Lingus, and the military, and commanded advanced aircraft including the Beech 200 Super King Air and Saab 2000.

Following a life-changing chemical accident in 2001, Andrew rebuilt his flying career from the ground up — with a stop at Jersey's *Le Manoir* and support from Lee Durrell and Colin Stephenson.

He earned an Honours degree at St Andrews, regained flight status, and became Chief Flying Instructor at RAF Leuchars, later instructing for *Aerobility* and on Tiger Moths.

Now semi-retired, Andrew continues to teach on simulators including the Boeing 737-800 and the world's only full-motion F4 Phantom simulator.

This is a rare opportunity to hear firsthand from someone whose life has been shaped by resilience, adventure, and a passion for flight

Runway ahead markings

In last month's newsletter we mentioned about the changes to the runway ahead markings. These have been updated to show the Runway designators at the runway holding points, but they will no longer be adding the additional Runway ahead markings.

Jersey Airport Emergency Exercise

The Emergency Exercise shall take place on Tuesday 7th October 2025 at Jersey Airport between 1900-2200. The Emergency Exercise is one that is required as part of the revalidation of the Aerodrome Licensing process and shall involve stakeholders from the Island's Emergency Services as well as Swissport and British Airways, who shall be launching their ERPs at waterside in conjunction with the event. Ports of Jersey are looking for volunteers to take part as passengers in the exercise to which we welcome anyone to take part.
